APPLICATION ADVICE	<b>Substrate preparation / Pre-wetting:</b> See leaflet "General Application Advice Exzellent STP system". Prior to application of Exzellent STP 610 the substrate must be pre-wetted thoroughly. A closed water film must be avoided. When starting application the substrate should be slightly damp.			
	<b>Mixing:</b> When applying Exzellent STP 610 by hand, the material is sprinkled into the water provided while stirring continuously, mixed homogeneously and without lumps until a hand plaster suitable for processing is obtained. For mixing double agitators must be used for mixing. Mixing by hand is not permitted. The material must be mixed for two. The material must be mixed for 2 minutes and, after standing for at least 1 minute, mixed again for 30 seconds.			
	<b>Render build-up:</b> Exzellent STP 610 is a final coat and part of the Exzellent STP render system. To achieve the full moisture regulation effect, a minimum layer thickness of 20 mm is to be applied. For detailed information on render build-up please request our special advice.			
	<b>Application:</b> Excellent STP 610 can be applied to the masonry in one or more layers on the masonry. In order to ensure open pores, Exzellent STP 610 is to be warped with an h-cartridge and cut with a trape- zoidal cartridge. For machine processing, the usual fine plaster machines including plate remixers can be used. Please ask for our special advice or the equipment planner for mechanical plaster processing.			
	<b>Surface finish:</b> See leaflet "General Application Advice Exzellent STP system". The surface may either be finished in its own juice, without addition of extra water, using a foam rubber or felt float or finally abraded using a grid- or surface float. Exzellent STP 610 must not be finished with a sponge board under any circumstances!			
	<b>Curing:</b> Exzellent STP 610 must be prevented from drying out too rapidly and protected from direct sun and wind exposure.			
	<b>General information:</b> Painting of final coats should be avoided, if possible, to retain the high "breathabili- ty" of the render. If a coat of paint is required, do not use any vapour sealing paints or coatings under any circumstances. Only highly diffusible, silicate-based paint coats with the following characteristics are per- mitted: Diffusion resistance Sd-value: < 0.01 m.
